Title of the Activity	Crisis in Agriculture and Way Forward: Peasants' Assembly 2024 on Food Sovereignty, Agrarian Reform and Peasants' Rights
Activity Description	Brief Description of Topic (sub-theme) Nepal has enshrined Food Sovereignty as fundamental right of the people in its constitution. There are strong and justifiable policies on food that could guide country's agricultural development to end hunger, achieve food security and food sovereignty, improve agrarian reform, ensure peasants' rights, and promote sustainability. However, the challenge and the dire need has been to learn a lesson from the past and emphasize on the effective implementation of the numerous guiding policies to achieve right to food a reality for all.
	All Nepal Peasant's Federation (ANPFa) is an organized voice of Nepalese peasants which has been fighting against feudalism, imperialism and neo-liberalism and also restlessly struggling for agrarian reform and defending peasants' rights to food, land, water and productive resources. The coalition provides its support to organizations representing peasants and other rural workers in the country to protect and claim their rights and interests. Asia Europe People's Forum (AEPF) is an interregional network of progressive civil society organizations from across Asia and Europe. Since 1996, the AEPF has consistently been a network linking Asian

and European NGOs and social movements. It is committed to fostering people's solidarity for a socially and economically just, inclusive, peaceful, sustainable and ecologically sensitive development, within and across the two regions.
